### Material:

- Recycled Paper Towel/ Toilet Paper Rolls
- Construction Paper
- Paint
- Paint Brushes
- Markers
- String
- Scissors
- Glue

missing their binoculars. You won't be able to get a better view of the animals without them and need to think quick! You come up with the idea to make your own and need to show everyone how it's done!

- Give your explorer two paper towel or toilet paper rolls (Make sure both are the same size)
- Have them decorate both rolls with either paint, construction paper, or markers (Let dry)
- Glue both tubes together
- Add a string that can be glued or stapled to both rolls (This will allow the rolls to hang from the explorer's neck)
- Let dry
